
CONVICTED MURDERER ALFREDO CASILLAS

But crime not "violent" under CA law, so he was granted early prison release.



While in prison for murder, Alfredo Casillas attacked another inmate with a knife and razor blades, slashing him in the neck, face, shoulder and stomach. But under California law, assault with a deadly weapon is not legally a "violent" crime, making Casillas eligible for early prison release.

The "Reducing Crime and Keeping California Safe Act" makes violent crimes "violent" to stop early release.
