## ASSAULTED A POLICE OFFICER BY RAMMING HIS PATROL CAR

**Crime not “violent” under CA law,  
so eligible for early prison release.**



In 2008, William Murphy, Jr. failed to pull over during a vehicle stop and led Clovis Police on a high-speed chase, during which the suspect intentionally rammed the driver's door of a patrol car blocking his path, then tried to flee on foot. But under California law, assault on a peace officer is not classified as a violent crime, making Murphy eligible for early prison release.

The **“Reducing Crime and Keeping California Safe Act”** makes violent crimes “violent” to stop early release.
