But crime not “violent” under CA law, so he was granted early prison release.

John Jerome Ursich was sentenced to 13 years in prison for stabbing and beating his victim, causing critical injury requiring two months of hospitalization. But under California law, assault with a deadly weapon is not legally a “violent” crime, and Ursich was granted early prison release.

The **“Reducing Crime and Keeping California Safe Act”** makes violent crimes “violent” to stop early release.
