“Makes us less safe”

No on 20 ads on Facebook

Prop. 20 actually ensures that Prop. 57 does what it promised voters it would do — allow early release **ONLY** for NON-violent offenders — which means Prop. 20 will reclassify the following crimes as “violent” and no longer eligible for early release: **selling a child for sex, rape of an unconscious person, domestic violence**. As a result, ensures that those convicted of these crimes have full access to the rehabilitation programs offered by the state.

“Retrograde and racist”

Prop. 20 does not repeal any previous reform, just closes loopholes. **Prop. 20 is colorblind and treats all equally**. However, crime does not. Dept. of Justice statistics show that underserved communities are most often the victims of violent crime.
